The Chambers have adopted and We hereby give royal assent to the following:

**Article 1** The following international acts shall come into full effect:

1. Treaty establishing the European Economic Community and the appended acts;
2. Treaty establishing the European Atomic Energy Community (Euratom) and the appended acts;
3. Convention on certain institutions common to the European Communities,  
signed at Rome on 25 March 1957;
4. Protocol on the Statute of the Court of Justice of the European Economic Community;
5. Protocol on the Statute of the Court of Justice of the European Atomic Energy Community;
6. Protocol on the privileges and immunities of the European Economic Community;
7. Protocol on the privileges and immunities of the European Atomic Energy Community,

signed at Brussels on 17 April 1957.

**Article 2** The Government shall present a report on the implementation and application of these Treaties and the appended acts to the Legislative Chambers every year.
