

Resolution (49) 22 of the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe (4 November 1949)

Caption: On 4 November 1949, meeting in Paris at the French Foreign Ministry, the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe adopts a resolution which postpones Austria's accession to the Council of Europe until the Austrian State Treaty is signed and occupation forces withdraw from Austrian territory.

The Committee was in favour of admitting Austria to the Council of Europe as soon as possible, but considered it desirable to postpone its final decision until after the signature of the Treaty with Austria and the withdrawal of the occupation forces from Austrian territory.
