## Interview with Hubert Ehring: the signing of the Rome Treaties (Uccle, 25 October 2006)

[Étienne Deschamps] What can you recall of the official signing ceremony for the two Treaties that took place in Rome?

[Hubert Ehring] You know, the Italian State takes its official representation very seriously. The organisation of this ceremony was in keeping with this approach. You will agree that the Capitol is an important historic building; well, I had a small office in the Capitol museum, just opposite some old Dutch masters hanging there. From there, I went into the room where the signing took place. After it, there was, of course, the reception.

It is not easy, you know... I cannot recall anything that is really worth telling you here, but it was, of course, the big event of my life — of my professional life, at least.
