II. The European organisations

- EU is created and defined by the TEU and TFEU
- Council of Europe / Conseil de l'Europe / Europarat
(not to be confused with the Council of the European Union (Article 16 TUE) and the European Council (Article 15 TEU)!)
- European Free Trade Association (EFTA)
members: Iceland, Norway, Switzerland, Liechtenstein
 - EFTA Member States (exception for Switzerland) and EU Member States = European Economic Area (EEA) / Espace économique européen (EEE) / Europäische Wirtschaftsraum (EWR),
- Others, e.g.:
 - Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD)
 - North Atlantic Treaty Organisation (NATO)
