The situation in Spain

Message from the President of the Assembly
to the Chairman of the Political Committee
dated 6th April 1962

Spanish Ambassador called on me yesterday having heard Political Committee meeting during weekend to discuss i.a. inclusion Spanish question on agenda May Assembly. Protested strongly against Renger report which he considered wholly misinformed and an evil and unjust manoeuvre by hostile elements. Told Ambassador that Council of Europe obviously could not be disinterested in developments in Spain but to my knowledge Spanish question would not be on agenda in May. Spanish Ambassador in aide-mémoire given in Danish stated that Spanish Government would be available to Political Committee for enquiries and would be prepared either to receive members of Committee in Spain or send official Spanish personalities to contact Political Committee at any later meeting. Please communicate this information to President Struye. Airmailing express Strasbourg copy of note and Spanish commentaries on Renger report dated April 1962 and submitted to me this morning. Commentaries probably obtainable Spanish Embassy Paris but may already be in hands of Political Committee.
